We hope that this 106<sup>th</sup> year of our Alma Mater's founding was good to you and your families, and we wish you a Very Merry 2011 Christmas, and a healthy 2012. During 2011 we had 5 Alumni luncheons at the TAT, and one at the Aquinas Museum at Holy Family. Approximately 425 Alumni attended the luncheons. #### 100 Years Ago

The academic year 1911-1912 was singularly important for our alma mater. The name of the institution was changed from St. Patrick's College to Aquinas College. The Aquinas Literary Society was incorporated by the State of Ohio to serve as the legal entity able to form a college and university staffed and administered by the Dominican Fathers in Columbus. With this charter, advertisements for the institution announced that the Dominican Fathers were prepared to offer three courses of study: The College Course, the High School Course, and the Commercial Course. The full College Course seems never to have been realized. In the 1920s, the school becomes known as Aquinas College High School, a name it held until its closing in 1965. Enrollment grew at St. Patrick's College from its founding. By 1911, the original building, known as the Meaney Building, was unable to handle adequately the increased number of students. Plans were developed in 1911 for what became the faculty house and four additional classrooms. Constructed in the spring of 1912, the new addition was ready for the school term beginning in September 1912.

#### **Aguinas Scholarship Endowment Fund**

The primary sources of revenue for this charity are the Charlie Mentel Memorial Golf Tournament held in June, a raffle, and donations. The 19<sup>th</sup> annual tournament being held next year will be Friday, June 15, 2012. The golf tournament and raffle were very successful this year contributing over \$29,500 to the Fund. This year \$25,075 was given out in scholarships. Since its inception over \$257,500 in scholarships to area Catholic High Schools have been given to deserving 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduates of Parochial schools in the Columbus Diocese.
